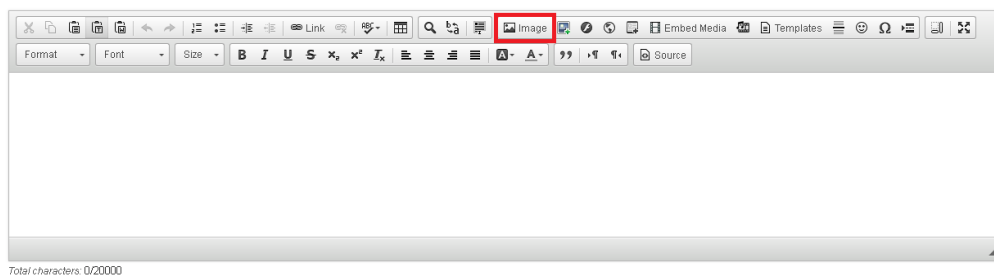

How do I make an image a clickable link?

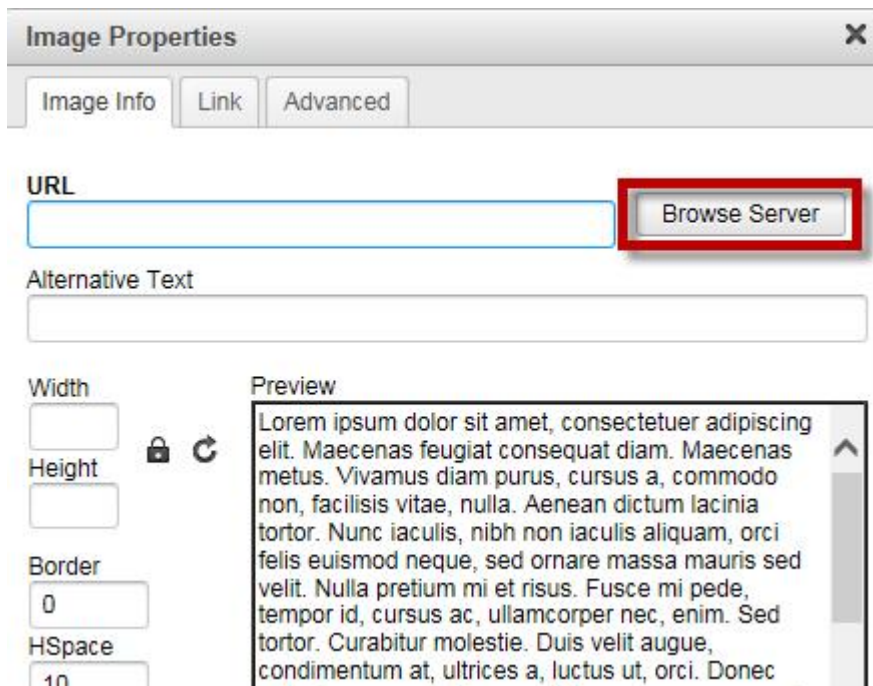

If you have embedded an image into a story or custom page, you can turn that image into a clickable link. To do so, open a story or custom widget and follow the below steps:

1. Click on the **Image** icon in the editor toolbar.



2. Now click on the **Browse Server** button



3. The **Media Library** should appear in a new window. Select your image from the folders, and double click on it.

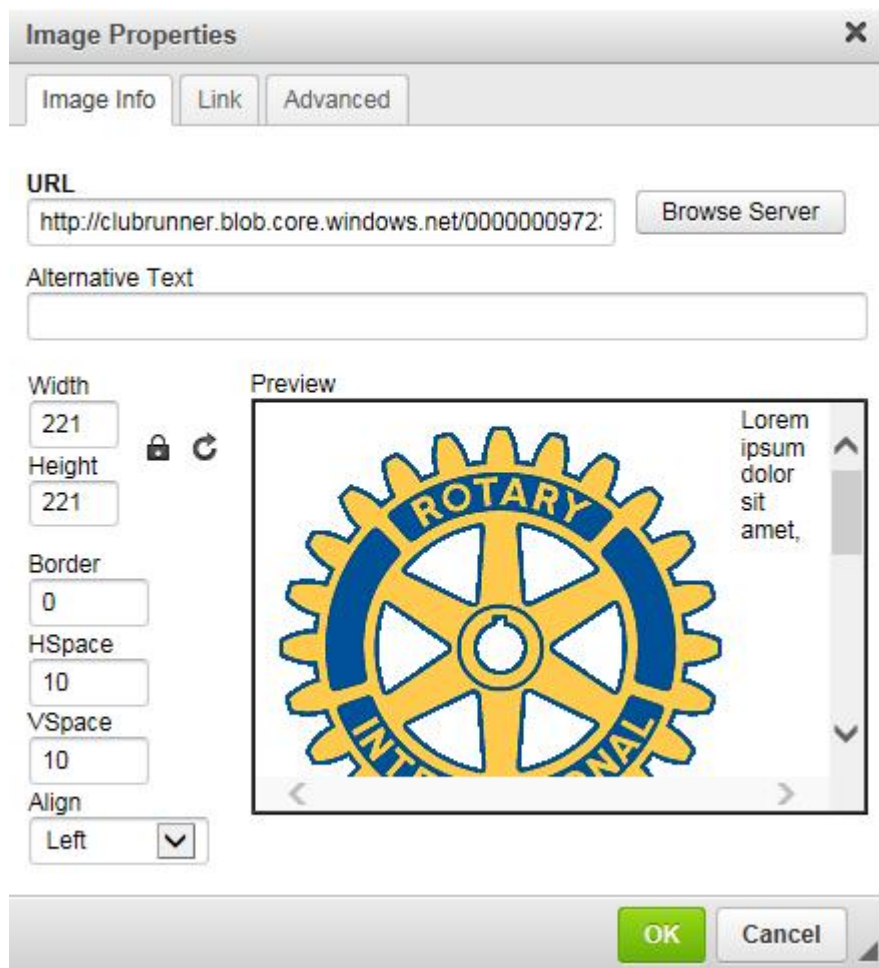
Media Library

To select an image from any library, **double click** on the thumbnail.

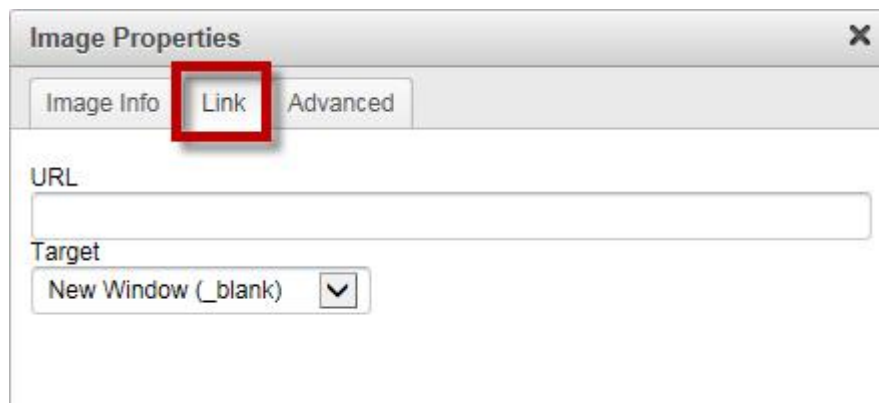
Note that the first two folders are shared libraries and images cannot be uploaded to your own website's library and can be customized. To upload a new image, click on the top.

Maximum file size for upload is 10.00 MB.

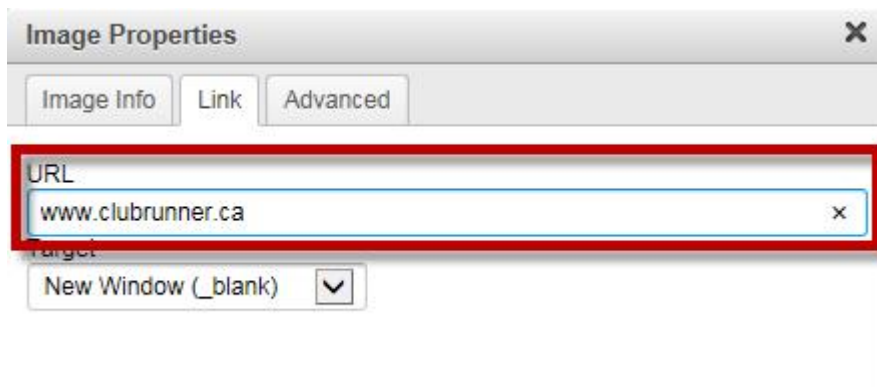

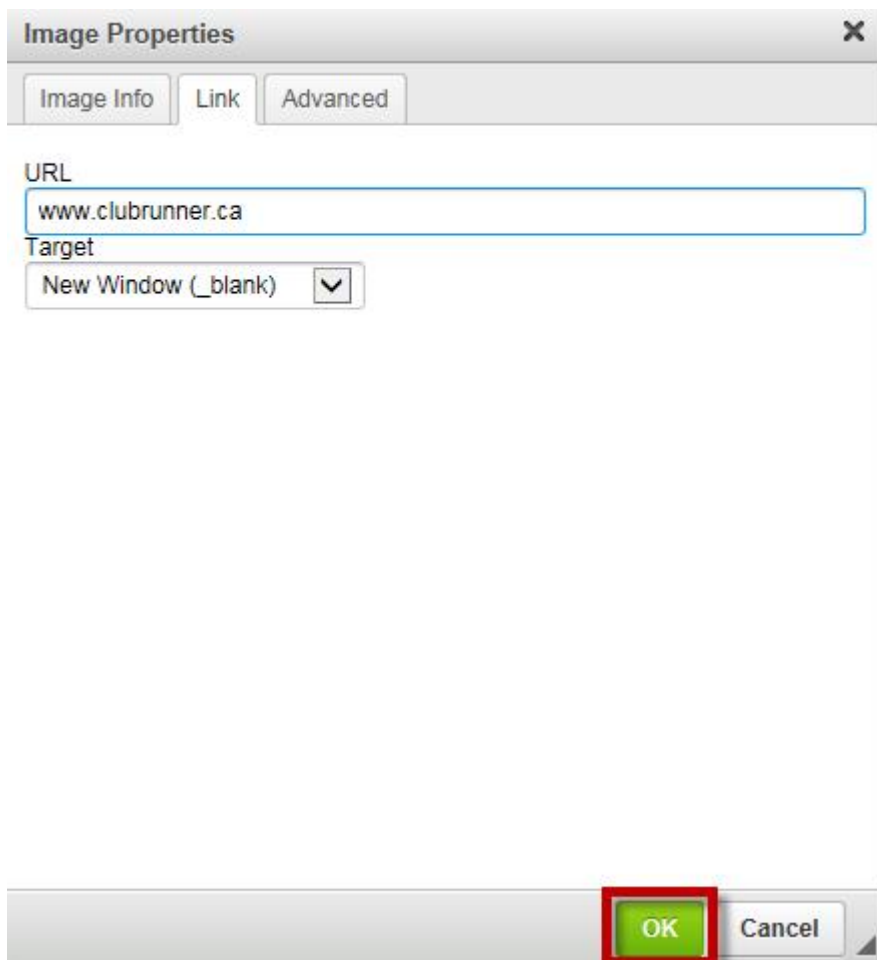
4. Now back at the **Image Properties** window click on the **Link** Tab



5. Enter the **URL address** that you want the image to link to. Eg: www.ClubRunner.ca

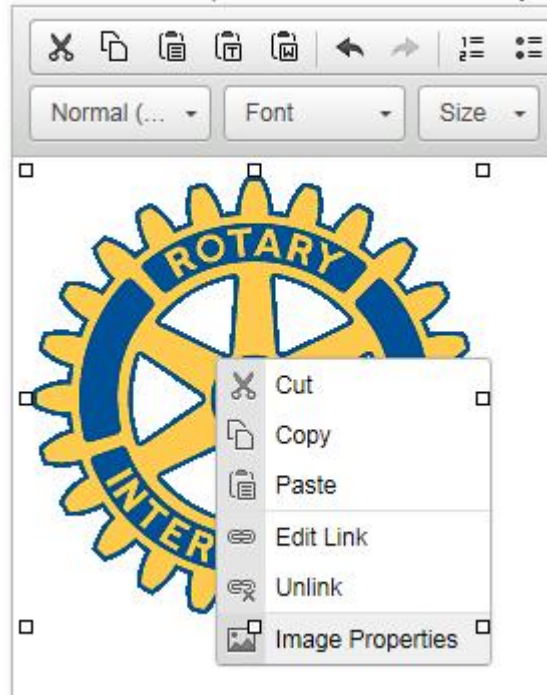


6. Now click the **OK** button.

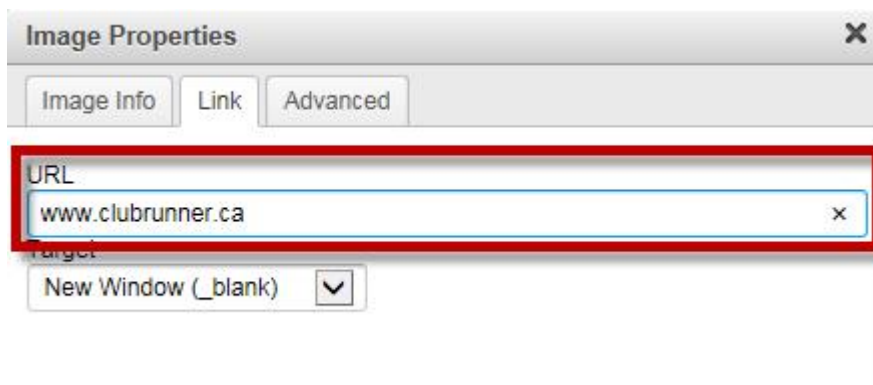


7. If you want to turn an existing image into a clickable link, right-click on the image and select **Image Properties** from the drop-down menu that appears.

8. In the **Link** field of the **Image Properties** window, enter the appropriate URL.



9. Click **OK** to save.
