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## Where can I view my committees?

ClubRunner makes it easy for you to view your club's committees and sub-committees, and find out what role your fellow members play on a given committee. To do so, you must access the **My Committees** feature.

1. To access My Committees, you must go to your club homepage and log in. Then, click on **Member Area** on the top right, under your club banner.
2. Along the top of the screen you will see several tabs. Click on the **My ClubRunner** tab.
3. Then, click on the **My Committees** tab.
4. This will open the **My Committees** window. Here, you will see a list of your committees. In this example, the member is on the club's food drive committee.

5. When you click on the name of the committee, or the **View Committee** link you are taken to a page listing the committees members, their position on the committee, their access level, and their contact details. Clicking on a member's name brings you to their profile page.
